Gradual relaxation of restrictions on entry to Switzerland



Travel agencies

Allowed since end of May



Religious services (from May 28)



Gatherings of up to 30 people (from May 30)

Open or allowed since June 6



Zoos, botanical gardens and swimming pools



All other educational institutions



Theatres and cinemas



Gatherings of up to 300 people, incl. sports fixtures



Mountain transport services



Restaurants and bars

From October 1



Organisers of events of more than 1,000 people can apply for permits
